## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Hotel accommodations:** We have a block of 20 rooms at the Hawaiian Hilton Villages @ \$145 per night for single or double occupancy, plus applicable taxes. The attendees aren't required to stay there, although our extra curricular activities are centered at the hotel. It's right at the beginning of Waikiki, close to Scottish Rite and parking is convenient. **Registration:** *The registration for voting members and visiting brethren will open 1 hour before the start of each business session. Voting credentials as well as banquet tickets may be picked up then.*

*A special request is being made for our Friday's registration time, please do not arrive early as there will be another group using the facility as well and we have promised not to interfere or disturb them. We promise, there will plenty of time to register before the business session begins.*

**Credentials:** *Please make sure to have ready and present proper Personal and Lodge documentation when registering for your voting credentials. This will save confusion during registration time.*

### **Event Dress Code:**

*Business Meetings - Either your lodge officers attire or coat and tie are appropriate.*

*Grand Masters Banquet - Saturday Night - Black tie preferred or business suit.*

**Lost and Found :** *Please check with the Grand Secretary at his desk if anything has been lost or stolen.*

**Voting Protocol :** *There will be three (3) speakers allowed for and three (3) speakers allowed against a proposal. All speakers being allowed three (3) minutes each. Speakers will alternate between those for and those against. The proponent of the proposal will be allowed to speak on the proposal but will be one of the three (3) allowed. He may speak first or last as he chooses. But should declare said choice at the beginning to insure the opportunity to speak.*

*Voting for legislation will done collectively by Ballot Card. Cards will be collected at the end of each business session and results will be posted Saturday night at the entrance to the Grand Masters Banquet as well as on the Grand Lodge Web Site as soon as possible following the Annual Communications weekend. The results will also be sent to the Secretary of each lodge via email. Only one (1) card will be issued per voting registrant for each business session.*
